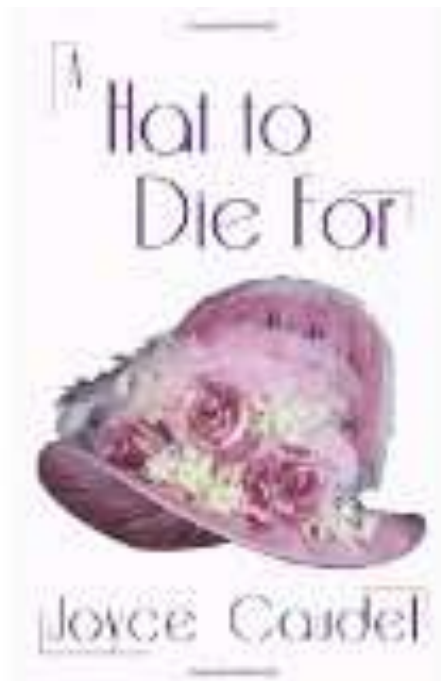


A Hat to Die For
