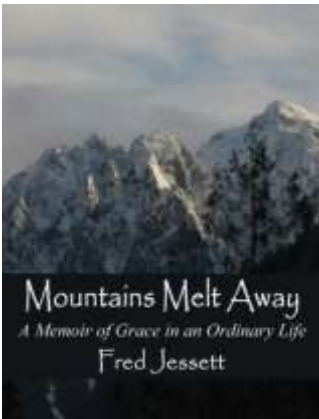


Fred Jessett

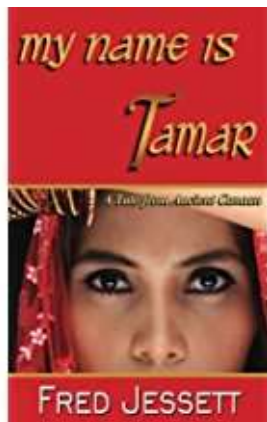

## **Mountains Melt Away: A Memoir of Grace in an Ordinary Life**    **B00KD5KWIW**



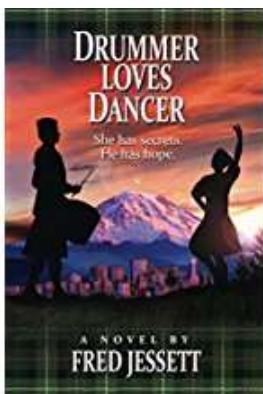
