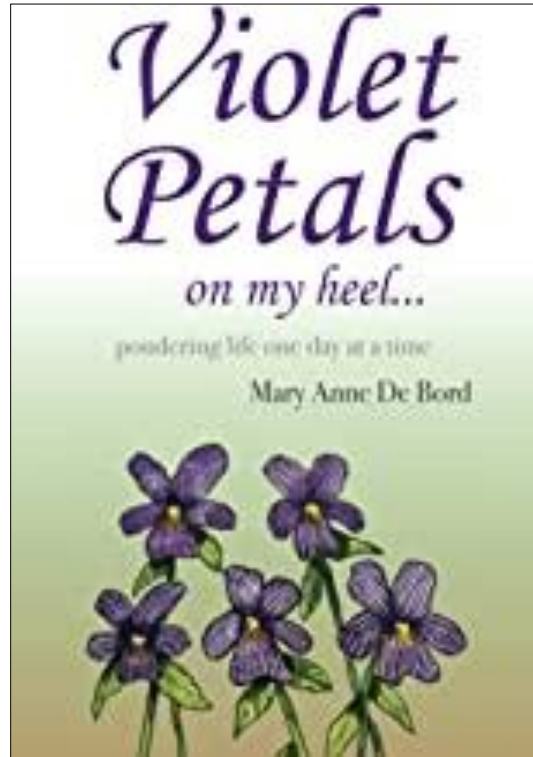


# Violet Petals
